LINE-UP CHANGES - The Sports Committee has tried to accommodate the bowlers when they are short men or need to make changes, but this has got out of hand and abused. We cannot guarantee subs for your team or doubles. We must have one (1) hour lead time to make changes. If you are short, or a bowler is late, you will receive a (0) for each frame missed. No make up. The one hour rule will be enforced with no exceptions. We will not hold up the start of a session.

All line-up changes 1 hour before bowling, check in time 1/2 hour before bowling

ALL TEAMS & INDIVIDUALS must enter their Highest Firefighter Tournament Average or USBC Sanctioned League Average for 21 games or more for previous 2018-19 season. If no average last year use highest current season USBC sanctioned league as of January 1, 2018 for 21 or more games. **IF CURRENT SEASON AVERAGE FOR AT LEAST 21 GAMES AT THE TIME OF BOWLING EXCEEDS LAST SEASON'S AVERAGE BY 10 OR MORE PINS, CURRENT SEASON AVERAGE MUST BE USED. WHICH EVER IS HIGHER, FIREFIGHTER OR USBC SANCTIONED LEAGUE MUST BE USED.** No summer league averages accepted. The Tournament Director reserves the right to rerate averages prior to the participant's bowling. If the rerate is not accepted by the bowler, the entry fees will be refunded. If none of the above provisions are met, bowler must enter at 160 average.

AVERAGES - (Rule 319a) All averages used must be "USBC" league averages.

(Rule 319a) It shall be each bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of his average in handicap tournaments, whether submitted by the bowler, his team captain or others. Failure to use the proper average shall disqualify the score if submitted average is lower than actual average thereby resulting in a lower classification or more handicap. This will cause score to be thrown out. If average submitted is higher than actual average his score will be refigured at actual average.

All bowlers may participate only once in each event.

EACH TEAM CAPTAIN SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE COMPLETION OF THIS ENTRY FORM: He will be held responsible for the Fee charged, for any check returned because of insufficient funds.

HE SHALL:

- be responsible for the conduct of team members;
- have an official of his local sign in the place provided as verification of entire team's membership in the local, see that the average of each team member is true and that the league secretary signs in the place provided as verification. If a bowler shows up intoxicated to bowl or becomes unruly, the Tournament Director has the right to order the Team to replace said bowler with a substitute.

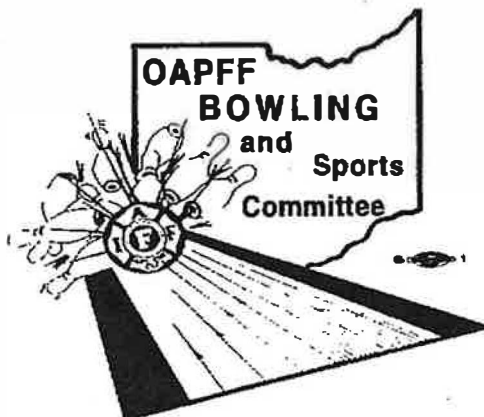

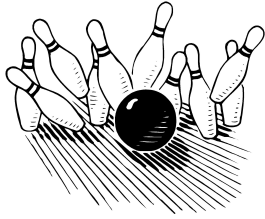

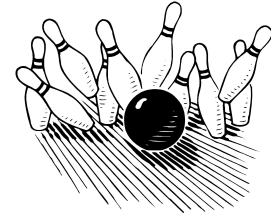
